## **Think Children(Registered Charity no. 515665)**

Think Children is a charity that has supported 568 primary school children providing 6355 sessions during the last school year. The service was delivered in over 100 schools across Nottinghamshire working with children who require help and support with their social, emotional and behavioural needs. This free emotional well-being service is taken to the child supporting them in their school working with them on a 1:1 basis addressing many different issues that may cause a child anxiety or distress. The trained facilitators, through play, offer children the chance to develop coping skills to deal with the situations they face at the onset of a problem before it becomes deep rooted and needs more specialist help.
