

SCHOOL DRESS CODE

At Carsic Primary School we have a school uniform, which we encourage all children to wear. Wearing a school uniform encourages a feeling of belonging and prevents arguments about what is acceptable to wear at school. It also reduces children's desire to compete about who has the best 'labels'.

Carsic uniform

- Grey trousers or skirt or pinafore dress
- Royal blue sweatshirt or jumper or cardigan
- White shirt or blouse or polo shirt

We have sweatshirts and fleeces with the school logo on, which are available to buy.

In summer children may choose to wear –

- Grey shorts or blue gingham dresses

We encourage the children to wear sensible shoes at all times.

Physical Education

Children may take part in PE wearing their vest and pants, however the older children often want to change into shorts and t-shirts or leotards. We encourage children to wear a white t-shirt and blue shorts or leotard.

Jewellery

Wearing jewellery is discouraged. Jewellery can easily be caught on objects or other children, especially when children are running around at playtimes. We especially discourage the wearing of jewellery on days when Physical Education activities take place. For certain activities –

- Cooking or baking
- Swimming
- Outdoor pursuits

We will ask children to remove jewellery, especially on hands or around necks.

Staff are not permitted to help remove children's jewellery.
